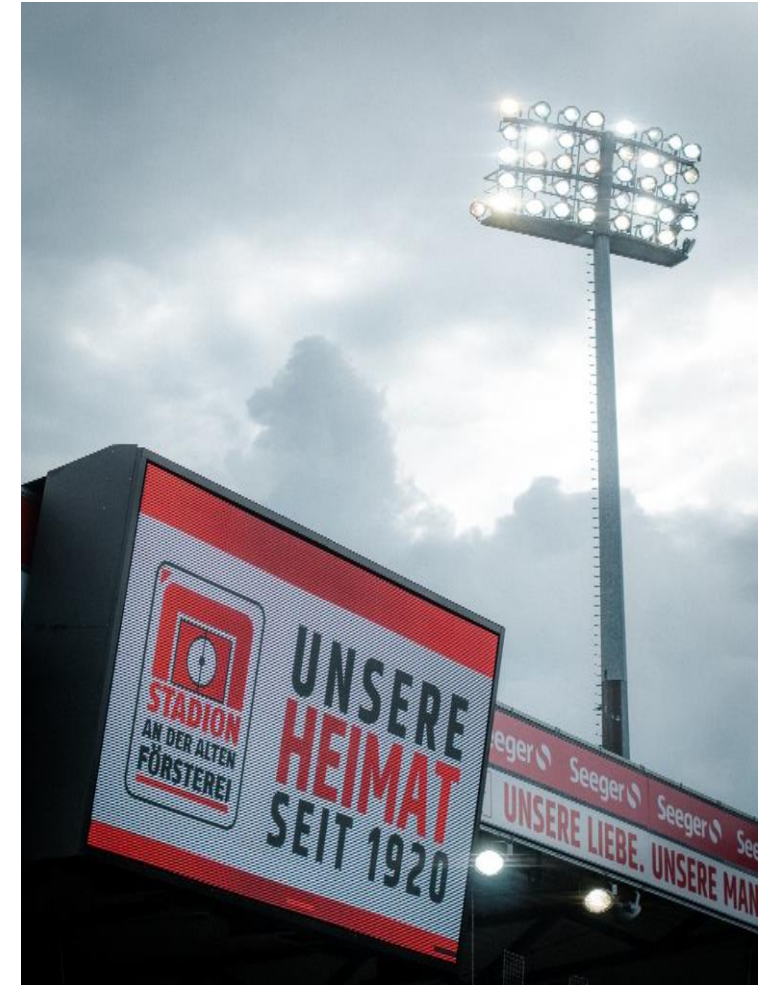

Dear media representatives,

Welcome to the media service of 1. FC Union Berlin.

In our media guide you will find all the important information and contacts for your visit to the Stadion An der Alten Försterei. Everything here applies to all home matches of the professional teams of 1. FC Union Berlin.



ACCREDITATION AND PARKING PERMIT



Accreditation for home games of 1. FC Union Berlin is only possible through the club's media department. To do so, please email the completed DFL accreditation form to Benjamin Blumeier. If you need a parking ticket, you can apply for one using the form. Please note that only fully completed applications can be considered.

The completed form must be received by us no later than **five working days before the match day**. In the case of a weekend match day, the deadline expires on Monday of the respective week at 15:00, for midweek match days it expires on the previous Tuesday at 15:00. We cannot consider accreditation requests outside of the deadline. Please note that accreditations can only be granted to adult and full-time media representatives.

NOTES FOR PHOTOGRAPHERS AND TV TEAMS



Notes for photographers:

For accreditation, you need sufficient professional liability insurance, KSK and BG ETEM membership and a valid press card (Freelens, AIPS, BDZV, VDZ, VDS, DJU, DJV). We ask that you have the relevant identification documents ready at all times on match days.

Notes for TV crews:

The accreditation of camera teams for the production of film contributions of all kinds is carried out exclusively by [Sportcast GmbH](#).

MEDIA WORKING AREAS



There are 50 seats available for **print and online journalists** in the press stand at the Stadion An der Alten Försterei.

Please note that taking photos, sound recordings and videos from the press stand is not permitted.

Photographers can obtain their grey identification bibs at the accreditation desk with a deposit (e.g. press card). Inside the stadium, photography is permitted behind both goal-lines and along the Gegengerade (main terrace) touchline from the goal-line to the 18-yard line. Photography is not permitted in any other areas (see section 5 of the stadium map).

MEDIA WORKING AREAS

Print journalists will have access to the **Mixed Zone** after the match for quotes.

Press conferences for the match will take place in the PK (press conference) room.



INTERNET/WIFI

Media representatives have **free Wi-Fi** access both in the press conference room and in the press stand.

The current access details will be displayed in the press conference room on match day. All seats in the press stand are also **equipped with network connections**, LAN cables can be provided if required.



ACCREDITATION COLLECTION AND ARRIVAL



Accreditations can usually be collected at the reception (to the right of the main entrance to the main stand) from approx. 120 minutes before the start of the match. You can access the press areas and the photo area inside the stadium via the red media gate, located to the left of the main stand.

The Alte Försterei can be easily reached by public transport. From Köpenick S-Bahn station (S3) it is a 10-15 minute walk along the railway embankment to the stadium. If arriving by car, **all members of the press who have registered for parking** can access the stadium via **car park P4**. This car park can be reached via Rudolf-Rühl-Allee (see stadium map number 10).
